TREASURER'S REPORT - PAUL EWART

The season got off to an ominous start with the transition to PlayHQ causing a few headaches for a number of our members. However, by the end of the season we had over 220 players register across juniors, seniors and indoors successfully signed up via the platform.

The Club once again ends the season in a strong position with a cash holdings of \$24.5k and no payables at balance date.

Membership income remained consistent with the prior year with both the senior and junior side of the club in a healthy position. Bendigo Bank remains a fantastic sponsor of the club and remains our major sponsor. In prior season we received a one-off bonus from Bendigo which explains the reduction in the current year.

Due to the great success of the Woolworths Blaster program on Friday night at Ferndale, social income saw a notable increase on the prior year. Margins on these sales saw a decrease on the prior year as the club expanded its offering to include food at events which were largely sold at cost. Overall, however the social income generates was a great addition for the club both financially and for the cultural benefits it demonstrates.

Overall, costs outside of social expenses remain materially consistent with the prior year. It is worth noting that facilities hire remain lower than historical amounts due to the absence from cricket at Ashburton Park. In the current environment all costs are expected to move in upward trajectory, and ground fees will be included in this. It is something the club must be agile to and respond accordingly. The support of the 1876 Club in allowing the club to pursue strategic objectives with their support remains an invaluable point of different for the club.
